Dear Brethren,

May the Lord bless you and keep you as you serve Him and remember His fellow servants. It is time to send you an update on the work of "Bible To You". We have continued to work with the students the Lord has given us to correspond with. Many of our incarcerated friends have been released to go home. Some students have failed to continue while others are steadfastly doing the lessons, sending notes of blessing of how the work has helped to establish their faith, change their life for good, and keep them stable in an unstable environment. We also continue to get new contacts for the lesson outreach, and we do rejoice, for our hearts are set on reaching and teaching the lost and straying.

All of this causes me to think of I Corinthians 15:58 "Therefore, my beloved brethren, be ye stedfast, unmoveable, always abounding in the work of the Lord, forasmuch as ye know that your labour is not in vain in the Lord." We are following this scripture though our bodies move slower. Thanks to you who pray, and to those of you who give financially to support this work, we are able to continue; thank you!

In January through March, we traveled south, sharing the ministry with churches from Virginia to Florida, and we were very well received and cared for. My verse for the trip was, II Timothy 2:2 "And the things that thou hast heard of me among many witnesses, the same commit thou to faithful men, who shall be able to teach others also." I believe we tried to do this. Only the Lord and time can tell.

A friend of ours, a former missionary to Granada, has been greatly used of God to return to Grenada twice, where he has been enabled to place King James Bibles in the hands of their public-school students and teachers. They were further asked to speak with the leaders of the country and present a Bible to each of them. As soon as Tom recovers from knee replacement sufficiently, he will be going back with enough Bibles to place one in every home. *Bible To You* lessons would now be a great aid in teaching there, as there are 14 Fundamental Baptist Churches on the island who's pastors stand ready. We have offered to get CD's. thumb drives or printed pages of the "BTY" lessons down there. Since we have lessons for soul winning and discipleship for primary, junior, teens and adults, God's foundational truths for theology, doctrine and true Christian living, they would be invaluable.

We are endeavoring to contact colleges and churches to set up a display for their conferences in coming months.
