Here is a Sugar Cookie Recipe that you and your parents can make.

Kids Sugar Cookies

1/2 Cup Shortening

1/4 Cup Margarine (softened)

1 Cup Sugar

2 Eggs

1 Teaspoon Vanilla

2 1/2 Cups Flour

1 Teaspoon Baking Powder

3/4 Teaspoon Salt

Beat together shortening, margarine, sugar, eggs and vanilla. Add in the flour, baking powder and salt. Cover and put in the refrigerator for 1 hour. Preheat oven to 350

Sprinkle counter with flour and roll dough out on top of the flour. Cut with cookie cutters. Place on ungreased cookie sheets and sprinkle with sugar. Bake 8 to 10 minutes or until lightly brown on edges. Get your mom or dad to check and see if the cookies are done and have them help you take them out of the oven!!! Cool the cookies on a rack or paper towels.

Now let's read John 3:16. "For God so loved the world that He gave His only begotten son, that whosoever believeth in him should not perish but have everlasting life." God loved us so much that he made a way for us to go to Heaven. Dina, the Bible says that whoever will call on the name of the Lord will be saved. That means to pray to God. Tell him you know your heart is black. Ask him to forgive you of your sins. Ask for Jesus to come into your heart."

Dina did just that, and when she looked up after praying and a smile was on her face. She was not sad any more; her heart was clean! Is your heart black from sin or has it been made white by Jesus' blood? Ask God to wash away your sin today. God never lies and He made a promise, "For whosoever shall call upon the name of the Lord shall be saved." That means saved from ever going to Hell. It means that you will go to Heaven when you die.

You can tell others the story of the heart. First, using a heart shaped cookie cutter draw a heart of each color, red, black and white. Write this Bible verse on a strip of paper and glue it onto the black heart - Romans 3:23. Write Colossians 1:14 onto a strip of paper and glue it






