If you sin again you can pray and ask God to forgive you---and He will! He will always love you. The Bible tells us in Jeremiah 31:3 "... I have loved thee with an everlasting love. . ."

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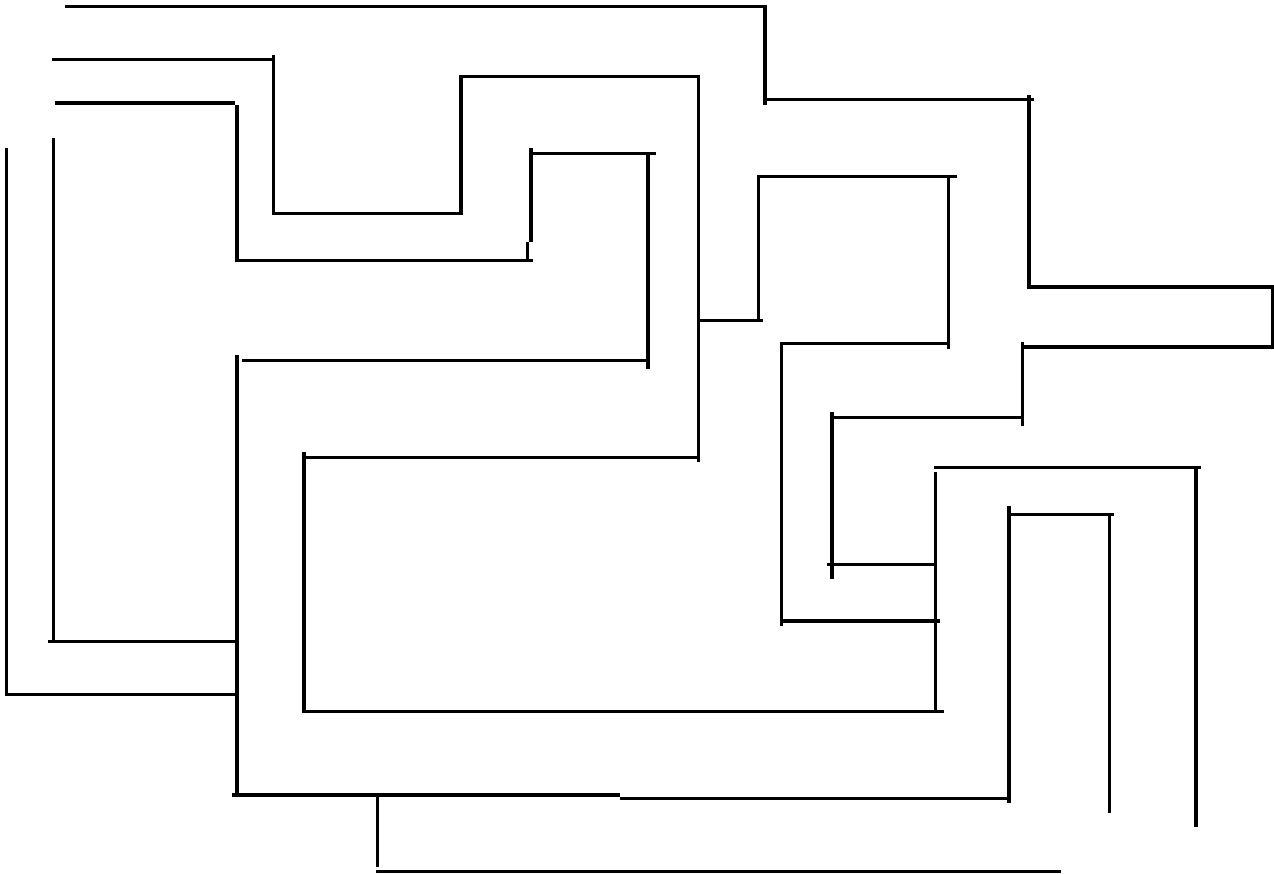
